## SPECIAL STUDENT APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Due to limitations of space, Georgetown is not in a position to offer admission to special (non-degree) students except in unusual circumstances. Admission for special students is normally for one semester and a second semester must be approved by the Dean's office. The following procedure must be followed:

Complete the entire application and submit it, with your transcripts and the application fee of \$65.00, directly to the dean of the school to which you are applying, Georgetown University, Washington, D.C. 20057. **Please make your check or money order payable to Georgetown University (No Cash).**

### **PLEASE SEND ALL COMPLETED MATERIALS TOGETHER.**

Submit a complete set of transcripts from your high school and any college level work that you have completed. You should enclose these with your application or have them sent directly from your school to the Dean's Office. In addition, please send any SAT or ACT test results that you may have received.

The Dean's Office must receive applications no later than July 15<sup>th</sup> for admission in the Fall Semester and November 15<sup>th</sup> for admission in the Spring Semester. Final decisions will be made by August 10<sup>th</sup> for the Fall Semester and December 10<sup>th</sup> for the Spring Semester.

Students who are earning degrees at schools other than Georgetown and who wish to attend Georgetown as "Guest Students" must attach to their special student applicant materials a letter from their Dean approving the credits to be taken at Georgetown for the degree at their own schools.
